

TONY DEAN

Tony Dean is a Professor in the School of Public Policy and Governance at the University of Toronto, and a Senior Research Fellow at the Harvard Kennedy School.

He advises on public service reform, with a focus on building capacity for policy and integrated service delivery.

From 2002 to 2008 Dean was Secretary of the Cabinet and Head of the 66,000-member Ontario Public Service. He also served as Deputy Minister of Labour, and as Deputy Minister of Policy in the Cabinet Office.

Dean has worked as an advisor to several federal government departments, the London-based Commonwealth Secretariat, Commonwealth governments and the Independent Evaluation Office of the International Monetary Fund.

Dean is a recipient of the Order of Ontario.
